



Korean Pronunciation Master Cheat Sheet



1 연음 (Liaison)

31 삼십일 [삼시빌]
[sam-see-beel]

✔ The final consonant slides smoothly into the next vowel.

2 ㄴ 첨가 (N-Addition)

66 예순여섯 [예순녀섯]
[yeh-soon-nyeo-seot]

✔ An 'N' sound is gently added to bridge the words naturally.

3 비음화 (Nasalization)

16 십육 [심눅]
[seem-nyook]

✔ N-Addition occurs first to make it [십눅], and then Nasalization softens the preceding 'ㅍ' into a 'ㅍ' sound.

4 유음화 (Lateralization)

16 열여섯 [열려섯]
[yeol-lyeo-seot]

✔ N-Addition occurs first to make it [열녀섯], and then Lateralization turns the meeting of 'ㄹ' and 'ㄴ' into a flowing double 'L' sound.
